

Frequently Asked Questions



- Q. How long will it take me to get my diploma?**
- A. The average length of time is between six months to one year.
- Q. Will my employer be told that I am getting a high school diploma?**
- A. This is a confidential program.
- Q. What days/nights are assessors available?**
- A. Staff is available based on a mutually agreed upon schedule.
- Q. Will I have to take any tests?**
- A. There is an initial appraisal test to determine reading and math skills. Also, the first phase of the program has an assessment in reading, math and writing.
- Q. What happens if I don't pass the test?**
- A. There is tutoring available to help you improve your skills.

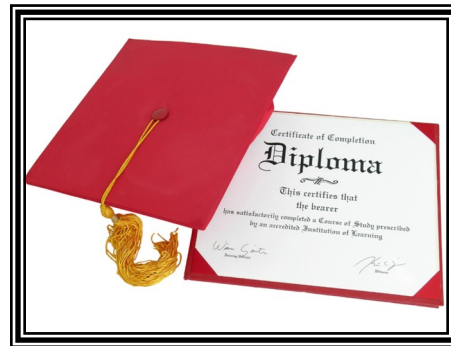

NEDP Sequence

- 1. Appraisal Testing**
Tutors available if needed
- 2. Diagnostic Phase**
Assessment of math, reading and writing skills
- 3. Assessment Phase**
Demonstration of competencies through computer use
- 4. Post-Task Assessment Phase (PTA's)**
Correction of those skills not demonstrated
- 5. Portfolio Review**
Verification of demonstrated skills
- 6. Individualized Assessment**
 - Employment verification, or
 - Instructor Verification of a Training Program, or
 - Advanced Academic Assessment, or
 - Verification of Occupational Skills, or
 - Personal or Management Skills Portfolio
